COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

Airpark: Established to increase awareness and the value of the airstrip for Sugar Springs Property Owners and to ensure the safety of the airstrip for the pilots, their planes, and the Sugar Springs Community. Meets April through September.

Architectural and Environmental Control: Established to protect and preserve amenities and qualities of the development. Reviews plans, performs site reviews, and meets with property owners. Meets weekly on Tuesdays at 1:30 pm, excluding holidays. (November – March winter hours will be posted)

Building and Grounds: Responsible to review, analyze, and prioritize additions, maintenance and care of all buildings and grounds. Meets monthly.

Budget: Assist the Comptroller and the General Manager in preparation of the annual budget. May include review, analysis, and recommendations on special assessment fees, and any other financial matter. Meets in October and November.

Camping: Serve as a Camping Advisory Committee to the Board of Directors. Review and implement camping policies for those camping on lots. Meets April thru September.

Election: Prepares ballots for mailing and handles return count. Normally meets four (4) times a year.

Golf: This is an elected position from the SSMGA & SSWGA. If interested in running for this position, please notify the Sugar Springs Men's or Women's Golf Association.

Lakes: Responsible to implement a lakes management program, which includes lake monitoring, weed control, silt control, shoreline stabilization, control of docks and placement of docks on commons property, and the promoting of boating and water safety. Meets monthly March thru October.

Memorial: Establishes a means for P.O.A. members and non-members to memorialize their loved ones by using donations for specific projects to honor friends or family members.

Nomination: Seeks candidates for nominations for Board vacancies each year. Meets approximately four times per year.

Planning: Develops and makes recommendations to the Board on short- and long-range plans for Sugar Springs. Takes Board vision and follows through on plans and marketing strategies. Meets monthly, with special sessions added as needed.

Recreation: Plans and organizes recreational or social activities for members. Meets monthly.
